Timing Notes

The bare requirements are for the presentation to last between seven and 10 minutes. This does *not* include the question/answer period at the end; it only includes time you spend presenting the material. Any presentation less than seven minutes, or longer than 10 minutes, will have 50% of their presentation grade deducted from their final presentation grade.

You are encouraged to bring a timing device of your own so that you can keep track of how long you have talked; I will.

Paper Presenters

For those of you presenting on the first day (April 9, 2007), you will need to upload your paper (or as much of it as you have done) to the Course Blackboard site by Saturday night. For those not presenting on the first day, you need to upload yours by April 9, 2007 at 8:00 am.

Paper Readers

For those of you assigned to read a specific paper, you will need to read it thoroughly and prepare a set of three questions to ask the presenter during the Q&A period. These questions must be substantive. For those who are not assigned to the paper, you are still responsible for reading it thoroughly enough that you know the main points and conclusions.

Remember that there is a final examination in this course. This final examination covers the first part of the course (the theory part) and this third part (the research presentation part).
